Loaves & Fishes

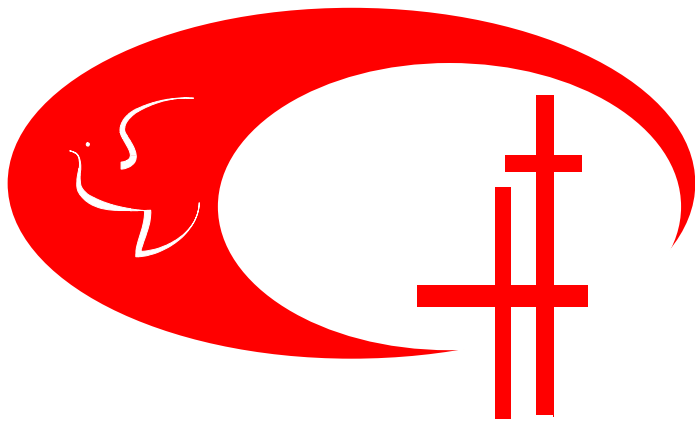
This Tuesday, August 26, 5 pm at St. Stephen's

Parish Pastoral Council

Following 6 months of study, prayer, discussion, consultation, writing and re-writing, the Parish Planning Taskforce, at its meeting on August 12th, adopted guidelines for the establishment of a new Parish Pastoral Council that embody the "shared wisdom/discernment" model of decision-making that is more and more becoming the standard for parish and diocesan leadership groups. With this work behind it, the Taskforce decided that, with the assistance of the planning office of the Archdiocese and other resources, it will focus its attention on the work of implementing the guidelines. In September, after the new academic year has begun, the new Council guidelines will be widely distributed to the St. Lawrence-Newman community, and the process for the formation of the Council explained. In the meantime, if you'd like an advance look at the guidelines, copies are available on the tables in the Gathering Space. The members of the Taskforce are: Teri Danckwart, Stephanie Heyroth, Brian Hunkie, Jackie Hunkie, TJ Mackenzie, Bill Murtaugh, Alice Moormann and Richard Hanson. I'm most grateful for their dedication to this work.
