Cost: \$5/adults; \$2.50/kids.

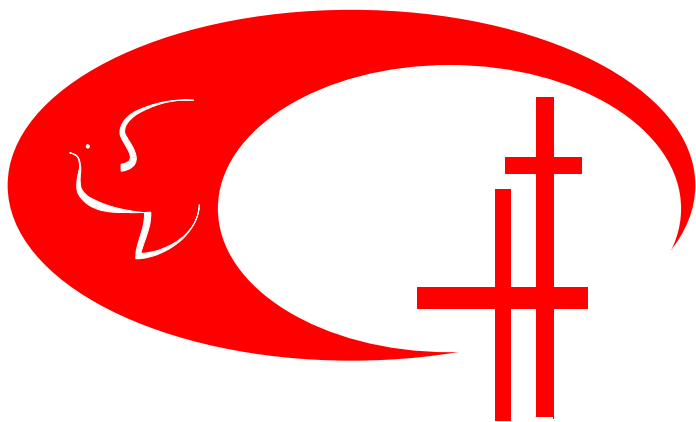
Outreach Sunday Next Week

Paul the Apostle

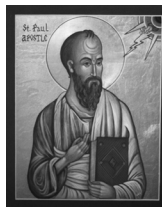
**Thursdays, September 11, 18 & 25
