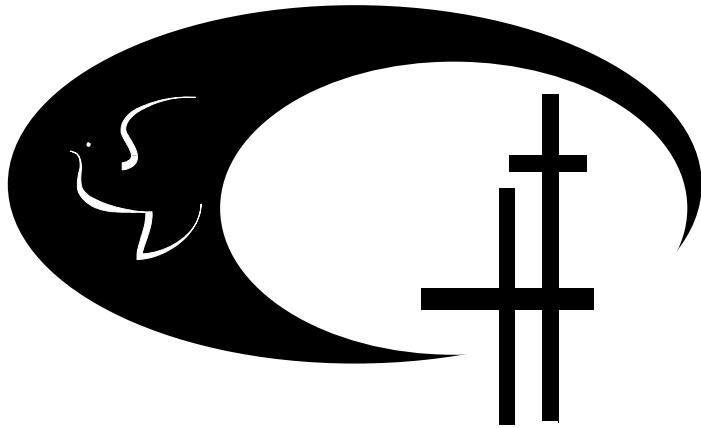
Outreach Sunday Next Week
