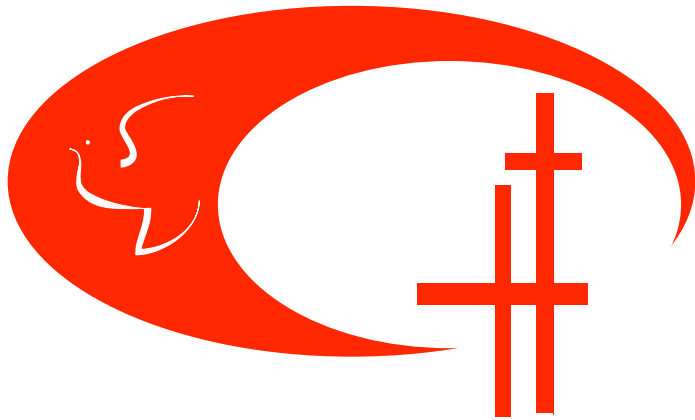

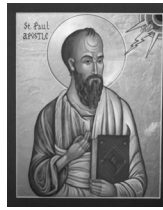
Brush Up On Your Faith
