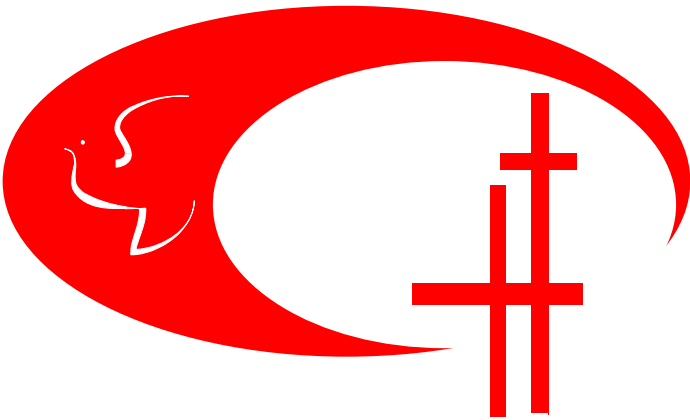

Forming a New Parish Pastoral Council

This past Monday evening the Parish Planning Taskforce met to continue the work of preparing for the formation of a new Parish Pastoral Council. At this meeting there was a lengthy discussion about "mission" —the mission of God (begun in the work of creation), the mission of Jesus as he furthered that mission, and the work of the Church —the universal church, the diocesan church, and the local parish —in the service of, and as an instrument of God's mission to the world. Following this discussion of mission, the Taskforce spent the remainder of the meeting working to create a draft of a new parish mission statement. At its November meeting the Taskforce will participate in the process of discernment that potential members of the new Council will experience. Following the Council guidelines adopted this summer, the Taskforce is on target for the formation of a new Parish Pastoral Council this coming spring. All members of the St. Lawrence-Newman community are invited to begin their own discernment about their possible service to the community through the ministry of Council membership. Copies of the Council Guidelines are available in the Gathering Space.
