

# Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

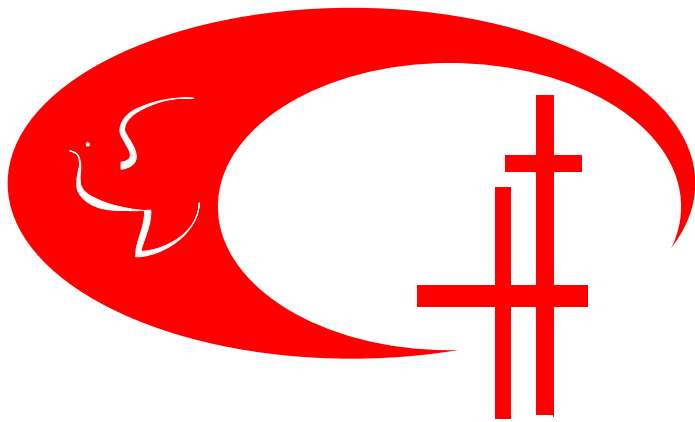


## What Is Today's Feast All About?

Today we celebrate the *Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome*.

Since most of the major liturgies are celebrated in the Basilica of St. Peter many people assume that it is the pope's home church; but his official cathedral is this church which is more commonly referred to as St. John Lateran. Given to the pope by Constantine the Great, it is one of the four major basilicas in Rome. Legend says the original building was dedicated as a church on November 9<sup>th</sup> in 324.

Like all celebrations of church dedications, today's feast really celebrates the living church more than the building. The building becomes a reminder that we are living stones who together form the church.

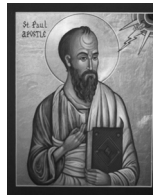
