

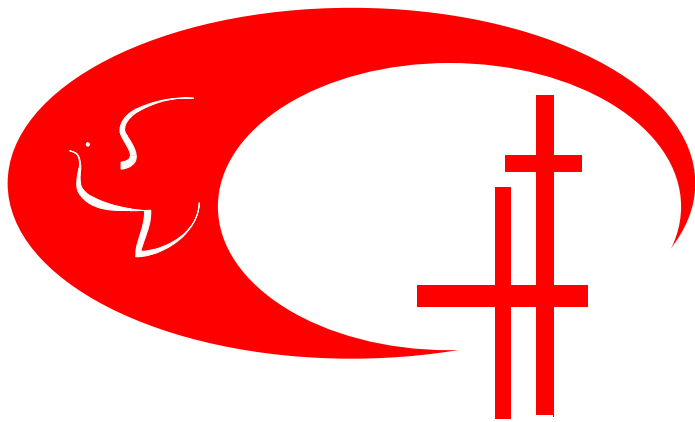


# Thanksgiving Day Mass

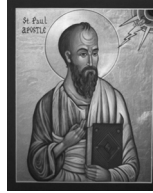
**This year the service will be at
