

## *A Prayer to the Apostle Paul*

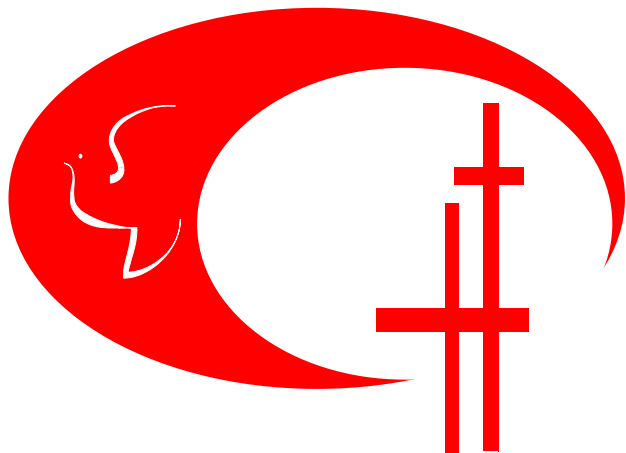
Glorious Saint Paul,
