Also of great need is packages of new socks and underwear for men, which will be donated to St. Stephen's shelter for homeless men.

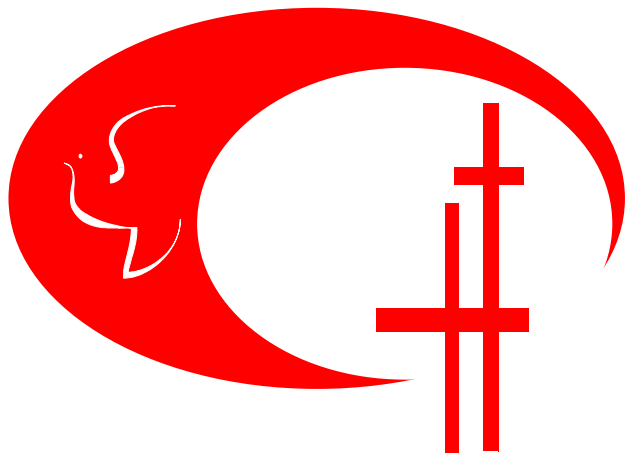
Chiapas fair trade coffee will be sold after the morning Masses.

The Catholic bishops of the United States have unanimously called us to prayer and action to prevent passage of the radical "Freedom of Choice Act" (FOCA) and to oppose other attempts to overturn existing pro-life laws and policies. This year our voices are needed more than ever.

We will be participating in a postcard program where you will be asked to write to your congressman and senators expressing this concern and asking that they refrain from supporting any such changes in laws and policies.

We have been assured that the cards would arrive by Friday, February 13. If they did indeed arrive, they will be available today in the Gathering Space.

Lifting of the Order of Excommunication

Much has been reported about the Pope's decision to lift the excommunication of the illicitly ordained bishops of the Society of St. Pius X and, of course, the holocaust-denying remarks of Bishop Richard Williamson. Through the lifting of the excommunication it seems to be Pope Benedict's hope that there can be a reconciliation between Rome and the members of the Society of St. Pius X founded by Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre. At the heart of this effort, though, lie statements like this of now –deceased Archbishop Lefebvre: *"We refuse...and have always refused to follow the Rome of neo-Modernist and neo-Protestant tendencies which were clearly evident in the Second Vatican Council and, after the council, in all the reforms which issued from it."* Obviously, much remains to be done if the members of the Society of St. Pius X are to be reconciled with the vast majority of the world's Roman Catholics.
